Hayes Green Beach Memorial Hospital's Breast Cancer Risk Assessment class at AL!VE helps women and men understand their risks for breast cancer.

Is this class right for me?

If you have a high risk for breast cancer, have a family history of breast cancer or have recently been diagnosed with breast cancer, this class will help answer questions about breast health, genetics, breast cancer screenings, self examination and diagnostic testing.

What is discussed during the class?

The hour-long class has five sections, including methods to determine breast cancer risk, frequently asked questions on genetic testing, what screening and diagnostic services are available, breast biopsy procedures and preparing for a breast procedure. The class closes with a 15-minute question and answer session.

What is the cost to attend?
